

### **Traffic**

While difficult to track there should be a safety plan in place for emergency vehicles. With limited roads in and out of Sterling strategically placing resources will be key.

This to take into consideration:

- Construction planning
- Vehicle counters so that we can better calculate the final economic impact and visitation numbers

### **Regional Impact**

While the viewing areas are concentrated from Auburn, north to Fair Haven/Sterling the impact will reach far beyond. Air B&Bs, home rentals, hotels, motels, campgrounds and all lodging will be occupied. Our neighboring cities Rochester, Buffalo and Syracuse are already filling up. Not only are we a destination in our own right, we will get overflow from these cities.

According to Columbia, SC their accommodations saw a **60% and 40% increase** in occupancy due to the eclipse.

## Retail Spending

In the path of totality day of event stores saw 246% increase, over the weekend the increase over **historic highs** were between 20-30%


