

Harriet Tubman National Historical Park



Seward House Museum



Famous underground railroad conductor Harriet Tubman chose to live the last 50 years of her life in Cayuga County. Walk in her footsteps as your group visits her home and the place where she worshipped.

Visit the home of William H. Seward, Secretary of State under President Abraham Lincoln. The Seward House Museum preserves the legacy of his bold political leadership—most notably his efforts to end enslavement.


Cayuga County also holds a special place in the women's rights and equality movement. The Equal Rights Heritage Center in downtown Auburn showcases New York State's pivotal role in advancing human rights, with interactive exhibits highlighting leaders who championed equality for all.

This rich history comes together at Fort Hill Cemetery, the serene resting place of Tubman, Seward, and many other influential figures.


Cayuga County is a destination where the past is not only preserved but deeply felt, inviting visitors to connect with the people and stories that helped shape the future of the nation.
